GLOSSARY OF THEATRE TERMS

Level: Elementary – ages 7-11

Vocabulary:

- 1. **STAGE RIGHT/STAGE LEFT:** To the actor's right or left
- 2. **UPSTAGE:** Stage position farthest to the audience
- 3. **DOWNSTAGE:** Stage position closest from the audience
- 4. **BLOCKING:** Stage movement dictated by the director and executed by the actors
- 5. **"OFF BOOK":** Lines completely memorized no longer needing the script
- 6. **CHARACTER:** Individuals used to tell a story
- 7. **APRON:** Portion of the stage on the audience side of the main curtain or grand drape
- 8. **WINGS**: The backstage area and to the sides of the playing area unseen by the audience.
- 9. **HOUSE:** The portion of the theatre where the audience sits
- 10. "PLACES": Positions the actors take prior to the beginning of the play, usually announced and called by the Production Stage Manager.
